The Fund continues to coordinate with law enforcement organizations and has a Law Enforcement Legislative Committee that meets periodically throughout the Legislative Session to discuss and work on legislation that affects the law enforcement community. The Alabama Peace Officers' Association has been very gracious to host these meetings at the Association office over the past several years and it is much appreciated.

The Annuity Fund's Actuary, Cavanaugh Macdonald Consultants, LLC; recently presented the Board of Commissioners the 10/1/2013 Actuarial Status Report of the Fund. As we have mentioned in past reports, the Fund continues to be challenged in receiving recurring revenue necessary to properly fund the Alabama Peace Officers' Annuity & Benefit Fund. The Actuary has indicated we can continue to pay the current benefits through 2014; but will need to earn a minimum of 7% on our investments and receive the same Annual Required Contributions to keep the Fund sustainable at current benefit levels in future years.
